In accordance with s79 and s80 of the 1972 Local Government Act applicants are required to confirm that they are eligible to become a member and are not disqualified to be a member of the Council.

Eligibility criteria (s79 Local Government Act 1972) applicants must be:-

- A British citizen or citizen of the commonwealth or the European Union and aged 18 years or older at the time of your application.

For the whole of the 12 months prior to your application you must:

- Have been an elector of the Parish and either occupied or owned/rented premises in the Parish or resided within 3 miles of the boundary of the Parish, or have your principal or only place of work in that area.

Disqualification (s80 Local Government Act 1972) You cannot become a councillor if you:

- Are subject to bankruptcy order or interim order
- Have, within five years before the day of application, been convicted in the United Kingdom of any offence and have had a prison sentence for a period of over three months
- work for the parish council
