Public Forum: The Chairman asked for a spokesperson from those present. A variety of questions and concerns were raised in connection with item 22 on the agenda - Forestry Commission. Particular concerns over the proposed use of the site and its close proximity to housing in relation to noise impact; traffic; environment; potential loss of value of property; tree loss and associated nuisance. The public present asked that a full public consultation should be carried out. The Clerk was requested to contact the relevant Council for the existing site at Cannock and ask for details of complaints made at similar events. The Chairman advised those present that this proposal had only just been received that the comments made would be noted and representatives from the Members would attend the screening meeting and pass on the concerns raised.

443. Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 28th November 2007

446. Referred from Planning Committee 10th January - Identification of New sites for Housing - a copy of the request from Policy Planning, Joint Partner Working Local Authorities had been circulated to Members with the Agenda. This was discussed. It was agreed that in this instance no response should be given. Proposed by Cllr R Warman, seconded by Cllr M Packham.

RESOLVED: No response to the request will be given.

- 447. Parish Assembly 9th May, 2008** – A suggestion on a possible speaker was discussed. It was agreed that the Clerk will inquire if Mr Brian Jackson, author of The Castleman Corkscrew may be available. Proposed by Cllr Dyer.
RESOLVED: The Clerk will approach Mr Jackson to discuss speaking at the Parish Assembly on 9th May 2008.
- 448. Parish Plan Monitoring** – Mr Ken Brooks. Chairman of the Monitoring Group gave an overview of progress to date and of ongoing issues. It was agreed that an article on progress should appear in the next newsletter.
- 449. Abbey Rose Footpath** – A report from the Clerk had been circulated to Members, a copy of which appears as Appendix B with these Minutes in the Minute Book. This was discussed. It was agreed that an article should appear in the next newsletter. Proposed by Cllr M Packham, seconded by Cllr Mrs K Redknapp.
RESOLVED: The Clerk will compile a suitable article for the next newsletter and ask for witnesses to provide statements.
 It was also agreed that the Clerk will write to the identified owners as discussed. Proposed by Cllr M Dyer, seconded by Cllr Mrs V Bell.
RESOLVED: To write to the owners as detailed in the report (Appendix B refers).
- 450. Regalia for Vice Chairman of Council** – This was discussed. Cllr Mrs K Redknapp spoke on the issue and requested consideration to be given to some means of official identification for Councillors when representing the Parish. It was emphasised that expenditure should be minimal. The Chairman circulated an example of a badge quickly and inexpensively constructed. This was discussed. The Clerk and Chairman will investigate the costs of producing some form of inexpensive identification for all Councillors for use at official events and functions.
- 451. Oaks Drive Petition for Street Lighting** – The Clerk reported receipt of a petition for street lighting in Oaks Drive signed by 30 residents of Oaks Drive. This was discussed. It was noted that DCC will only consider such requests with the support of the Parish Council and would their final decision would be based on funds available, night time accidents and crime statistics. It was agreed that the Council would support the request and write to DCC to request their consideration.
RESOLVED: To write to DCC in support of the request for street lighting in Oaks Drive.
- 452. Allotments** – A request from a resident for an allotment was received. It was noted that the Council has a statutory duty (Small Holdings and Allotments Act of 1908) to consider any such request and assess demand. It was agreed that Cllr M Dyer will compile an article for the next newsletter.
- 453. Notification of Matchams Licensing Hearing date – 7th March 2008**, the Clerk will attend. Cllr Mrs Warman will be representing residents as a District Councillor. Noted.
- 454. Play Park Fencing** – A report had been circulated to Members. A copy of which appears as Appendix C with these Minutes in the Minute Book. This was discussed. It was agreed to instruct KSP Fencing at a cost of £15 per metre to install and £5.50 to remove the existing fencing. Total cost approximately £1155.00 to install only and £352 to remove the existing fencing. It was agreed to purchase the metal framed, wood slat style of fence at a supply and deliver only price of £3387.18. All prices plus VAT. Proposed by Cllr M Packham, seconded by Cllr Mrs S Smith.
RESOLVED: To proceed with instructing KSP Fencing in respect of erecting the fence.
RESOLVED: To proceed with ordering the metal framed wooden slatted fence as detailed.

- 456. PACT Neighbourhood Management** – An invitation from PACT to assist in the development of a model of best practice has been received. This was discussed. It was agreed that Cllr Mrs K Redknap would represent the Council.
- 457. County Councillors Update:** Cllr Mrs Warman reported. There have been some closures as regards Day Centres to save costs including the Sturminster Newton Pool which had been stood empty for some time.
An application is being submitted to extend the visitor centre at Avon Heath.
Brian Frecknall has been awarded Volunteer of the year by Dorset Police.
- 458. District Councillors' Update:** Cllr Dyer reported. EDDC have agreed to appoint and additional member of staff to deal with issues relating to the RSS. A sum of £150,000 over 3 years has been agreed to appoint a consultant in this respect.
