**Open Forum:** Members of the public spoke on item 10 on the agenda, road safety in Hurn Lane. A number of further letters raising concerns were handed to the Clerk. The Clerk advised the meeting that the County Councillor Ann Warman supported the request for a SID. The resident had also spoken with the Police who have agreed to do some additional mobile speed checks. Cllr Mrs House will also raise the issue at PACT.

Concern was raised over the speed of vehicles along Woolsbridge Road, near to the High Street entrance. The Clerk will bring to the attention of the Police.

**220. Security measures of Parish Sites:** Cllr R Bryan reported that the bunds were now in place. Horton Road also has a trench as otherwise there may have been damage to the existing land drainage. Braeside road also has a bollard to protect the gate. Cosmetically work still needed to finish off. The estimate to bring in a contractor was for upto £4,000. Costs to date have come in at £848. Prices will be obtained to turf. Members unanimously agreed that a vote of thanks should be given to the working party for their prompt and considerable efforts in completing the project.
