**73. St Leonards Hospital Care Village** – Cllr Maddock reported on a presentation attended on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2007, arranged by Halcrow Group Ltd. Halcrow Group are the agents for English Partnerships who now own part of the site. Planning permission is being sought within the next 8 weeks. The presentation advised that since the original outline permission was given in 2004 some adjustments have been made to alleviate green belt concerns, including: all dwellings will be single storey, a reduction to only 125 dwellings; maximum ridge height of dwellings will be 6 metres and 25% will be affordable housing. There are currently no plans to construct a shop or doctors surgery as per the outline. The Victory tree will be retained. It was noted that the resultant additional sewerage and traffic access on to the site will need careful planning.
