435. Gypsy & Traveller Site Consultation – The consultation document shows two sites of interest to this Parish one of which is just outside of our boundary. The consultation and information provided and the information evening was discussed. Allegations that some residents within the Parish had been threatened and intimidated by unknown parties have been received. It was agreed that the Committee should recommend to full Council that a consultation response be submitted on behalf of the Parish electorate as a whole. The Clerk will draft a response liaising with Members on content. Key points made were: The site in this Parish was thought unsuitable as it is remote from facilities as specified within the site requirements; it is located some distance down a shared private road which is maintained at residents own expense and in the Green Belt. The additional traffic would cause excessive wear on the access road and individual residents would have to meet the remedial costs, damage to vehicles of residents and potential site users would result. General comment: For any policy to work we would impress the need for enforcement and compliance.

RESOLVED: The Committee Recommend to full Council that a formal consultation response be submitted in respect of this consultation.

436. EDDC Meeting on 1st February at Barrington Centre – The meeting is open to the Public and will allow for comments on the proposed LDF, no decision will be made at the meeting, but the public will be able to speak in the normal public forum section.
