16/2393	37 Bushmead Drive, St Leonards- Demolish existing dwelling and erect 1 X 4 bed house and 2X 3 bed chalet bungalows	No objection subject to approval by Natural England, and on condition that all three dwellings are provided with onsite turning provision and some additional plant/tree screening is put in place to ensure no overlooking into the rear of the adjacent property 35A Bushmead Drive particularly from Unit 3 in Lions Lane. The applicants indicated that these additional measures were acceptable to them.
