

St Leonards and St Ives Parish Council - Parish Council Vacancies

The Parish Council currently has two vacancies one in the West Ward and one in the South Ward. It is the Council's intention to fill the vacancies by co-option hopefully at the full Council meeting on the 25th April 2018. This means that residents and people who work within the Parish boundary may apply to join and the Council will choose a suitable applicant.

The Parish Council's role is to represent the interests of this community. Your Council is a corporate body, a legal entity separate from that of its members. Its decisions are the responsibility of the whole body. The Parish Council is completely separate to other tiers of government whilst they have very few duties they have a legal power to take action. The Parish Council looks after the Parish owned sites at Braeside Road, Horton Road Village Green and Jubilee Copse. In addition to this the Council is a statutory consultee and can influence other decision makers for example on planning matters including planning strategies for the future. They have the power to raise money through taxation.
