

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF AVON AVENUE, ST LEONARDS & ST IVES

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Avon Avenue, St Leonards & St Ives between Egmont Drive and Avon Castle Drive (in both directions), a distance of approximately 50 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation on 4th November 2020 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10th November 2020.

This Notice will enable South West Water safe access to carry out repairs to communications equipment in the highway.

The alternative vehicular route, which will be sign posted is indicated by the blue line on the map below.
