

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF AVON CASTLE DRIVE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Avon Castle Drive outside number 29 for a distance of approximately 51 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It came in to operation on 21st April 2021 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27th April 2021.

This Notice will enable South West Water safe access to carry out emergency works to repair a burst mains pipe.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is marked on by the blue line on the map below.
