- Botanical reports indicate the proposed mitigation measures appear unsatisfactory.
- Parking issues arising from visitors parking in residential roads to access the footbridge across the A31
- Traffic problems on the A31 caused by visitors accessing and egressing the facility on Brocks Pine
- Why is it a good thing to move the existing visitors centre onto land not owned by Dorset Council.
- Facilities of a similar nature in other parts of the country have been constructed in areas away from residential areas. Why is this one being considered for approval when it is near a residential area.

The PC does not consider that the amendments made significantly alter the planning application. As a result, it reaffirms its very strong objection to it. In response to comments regarding access to the proposed surf reef by pedestrians. The PC raises concerns over pedestrian access via the footbridge over the A31. Parking to access the footbridge is limited to narrow residential roads. If the surf reef were to proceed then the number of visitors parking on local residential roads will cause a great deal of disruption, nuisance and chaos, all to the detriment of residents. Experience has shown that visitors attending local attractions do not park in a considerate manner. They will not respect residents' access/egress to their properties or observe highway code rules on parking near junctions or double parking — on what are in most cases quite narrow roads.
